Notice of Civil Service Exam

Police Officer/ Patrolman Grade- City of Napoleon Police Department

ILLUSTRATIVE DUTIES - Includes, but are not limited to: performs general and advanced patrol, investigation and reporting functions. A police officer, patrolman grade, preserves and protects life and at times must place themselves in perilous or dangerous situations to achieve that goal. A police officer, patrolman grade, through enforcement of laws and ordinances, preserves the peace and protects the rights of individuals and groups.

- Must be a High School graduate or equivalent. Must be State of Ohio certified as a Peace Officer at time of appointment.
- Must be at the minimum age of 21 years old at time of application.
- Must reside within Henry County, Ohio; or an adjacent county of Ohio within 365 days of appointment.

The salary range for non- probationary Police Officer at Patrolman Grade for year 2016 is \$18.71 to \$24.43 per hour in five (5) steps.

Candidate must possess a valid Ohio driver's license or be able to obtain such prior to appointment and maintain the same during appointment.

Examination will consist of two (2) parts; one (1) part written and one (1) part physical agility.

Applicant may be subject to pre-employment drug screen, passing of a medical and/or psychological exam upon being offered employment.

Photo identification will be required for admittance to the Civil Service testing facility, preferably a governmental identification.

Must be a U.S. citizen at time of application or legally declared your intention of becoming a U.S. citizen prior to an application being filed.

Applications and other associated forms may be picked-up beginning Wednesday October 26, 2016 at the City of Napoleon's Administration office, 255 West Riverview Avenue PO Box 151, Napoleon, Ohio 43545, between the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday thru Friday or from our website, www.napoleonohio.com under Human Resources to download forms.

Upon receiving a minimum of a 70% score on the written examination, you may receive an additional 5% credit of your base earned grade for each of the following categories: an Associate or higher degree from an accredited college or university, eligible veteran's/military service credit, three (3) years of service on Napoleon Auxiliary and/or OPOTA certification. Regardless, no applicant shall receive greater than a 10% combined additional credit. To receive any of the above credits you **must** submit applicable documents such as a college transcript, and a certificate of service or honorable discharge or equivalent, or OPOTA certificate **with the application**.

Applications that have been signed and officially notarized must be returned along with any other applicable documents/ certifications, etc. to the City of Napoleon, 255 West Riverview Avenue, PO Box 151, Napoleon, Ohio 43545 by 12:00 p.m. on December 13, 2016 to the attention of the Human Resources Director. Notaries at the City Building may be utilized.

Testing date for written examination will be held on **January 7, 2017 at 8:00am** at the Napoleon Fire Department, 265 West Riverview, Napoleon, Ohio 43545. The physical agility test will be administered that same day to applicants passing the written exam. A release of liability must be signed by applicant prior to taking physical agility portion of the test.
