SUMMARY

This position is responsible for performing repairs and maintenance of passenger automobiles, trucks, and heavy equipment; does related work as required.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include the following. Other duties may be assigned as required.

- Does general repair work on light and heavy trucks, police vehicles, gasoline motors, tractors, bulldozers, graders and other city equipment.
- Replaces necessary units and related parts, including valves, pistons and main bearings, and assembles cooling, fuel and exhaust systems.
- Inspects, adjusts, repairs and overhauls brakes, ignition systems, differentials and rear axle assemblies.
- Performs welding and fabricating jobs, such as repairing frames, making trailer hitches and new fixtures from drawings.
- Tunes motors using standardize testing equipment.
- Maintains necessary records on work performed, hours, materials and parts used.

QUALIFICATIONS

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily with or without reasonable accommodation. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required.

- Good knowledge of materials, tools, methods and techniques commonly employed in the automotive mechanic trade.
- Good knowledge of the principles of operation of gasoline and diesel engines and of mechanical repair of heavy trucks and construction equipment and other automotive equipment.
- Skill in the use of hand and machine tools used in motor repair and adjustment work.
- Skill in gas and electric welding.
- Ability to understand and carry out oral and written instructions.
- Ability to adapt available tools and repair parts to specific repair problems.
