In order to keep the general public updated on the current COVID-19 situation in Napoleon, the City will continue to provide announcements on an as needed basis. Below are the latest announcements related to the Parks and Recreation Department:

- The Napoleon Golf Course will officially open for the season on Saturday, April 25th. There will be a number of regulations in place to maintain safety of both our employees and patrons. These regulations include, but are not limited to, one person per golf cart, no touch flagsticks, and only allowing a limited number of patrons in the clubhouse at one time.
- To coincide with the Governor's Stay at Home Order, the shelterhouse facilities will remain closed until that order has been lifted or modified to allow for gatherings to resume. Anyone who has rented a shelterhouse facility between April 7 and May 1 will be offered another available date or can request a full refund. The City will make a determination on opening the shelterhouses on or before May 1st.
- The City's Parks will remain open, which includes the restrooms. All playgrounds and basketball courts will remain closed until further notice. No team practices or activities are permitted on athletic fields.
- Recreation programs remain suspended until further notice. We will continue to take registration for youth baseball and softball leagues in anticipation of a late starting date. That date has not yet been established.
- The courtesy dock for launching boats has been installed at Ritter Park this week and is available for use. The boat docks are scheduled to be installed in mid-May. This operation is weather dependent and can only occur if the river levels allow for safe deployment. Staff will be monitoring the weather to make sure that the docks are installed when an opportunity is available.
