The City of Napoleon will be beginning a street tree trimming project on Wednesday, January 18, 2017, and will continue for the next 1-2 weeks. Tawa Tree Service has been contracted by the City to trim all street-side City owned trees (with the exception of a few private trees that interfere with public clearances) on the streets listed below. The streets to be trimmed are as follows:

N. Perry Street - Yeager Street to Shelby Avenue
Railroad Street - Scott Street to N. Perry Street
Knape Street - N. Perry Street to Alley
North Street - N. Perry Street to Oakwood Avenue
Railroad Street - Scott Street to N. Perry Street
Depot Street - Oakwood Avenue to Hobson Street
Detroit Avenue - Yeager Street to Dead End
Yeager Street - N. Perry Street to Oakwood Avenue
Oakwood Avenue - N. Perry Street to Lakeview Drive
Northcrest Drive - Oakwood Avenue to Derome Drive
Northcrest Circle - Northcrest Drive to Cul-de-sac
Derome Drive - Northcrest Drive to Northcrest Drive
Old Creek Drive - Oakwood Avenue to Cul-de-sac
Fair Street - Oakwood Avenue to Dead End
Bauman Place - Lakeview Drive to Cul-de-sac
Monroe Street - Oakwood Avenue to E. Riverview Avenue
Hobson Street - Oakwood Avenue to E. Riverview Avenue
Maple Street - Depot Street to E. Clinton Street
Vocke Street - Fillmore Street to Dead End
225 Fillmore Street
E. Washington Street - Monroe Street to E. Riverview Avenue
E. Clinton Street - Monroe Street to E. Riverview Avenue
E. Riverview Avenue - N. Perry Street to Commerce Drive

This is a routine maintenance trim to remove crowded, poorly attached, diseased, dead branches and debris, and to obtain eight (8) foot clearance over sidewalks and fourteen (14) foot clearance over driveways and streets. Some trees may need more work than others and will be done for the safety of the community and its infrastructure as well as the health of the urban forest. **We will not be removing any trees in this contract.**

Please take care when driving in these neighborhoods as there may be times where debris and equipment may limit access or partially obstruct the roadway. If you live in these neighborhoods, please try to park on adjacent side streets or in driveways to avoid falling branches and to allow access for the contractor vehicles.
