The City of Napoleon administration has been meeting regularly with local health agencies and other governmental agencies to monitoring the COVID-19 situation. We have received new information from the Governor's office and other local health agencies that has promulgated additional changes to City services. These changes are being implemented to continue to help protect City employees and the general public.

Below are additional procedural changes for the general public that will take effect immediately:

- Access to City-owned facilities is restricted to City employees only. Anyone that needs to enter a City-owned facility must receive prior approval from either the City Manager, Law Director or Finance Director.
- All park shelter houses, including the Oberhaus, Ritter and Wayne park shelter houses, are now closed until at least April 6th. This date could change as we continue to monitor the situation. Anyone that has rented a shelter house during this time will be refunded in full.
- The City is suspending all spring sports activities until further notice.
- City parks will remain open. The park restrooms will also remain open for those that need to wash their hands.
- The City will not be disconnecting utility services for nonpayment until further notice. Furthermore, late fees and penalties will be waived during the next billing period.
- The utility drive through window will still be open for those that would like to come to the City administration building to make payments.
- As noted before, the City of Napoleon **Spring Cleanup** event has been **postponed** until the **week of May 11th**. The reason for the postponement of this service is to limit the risk of the employees working during this event as this is one of the highest exposure risks for workers.
