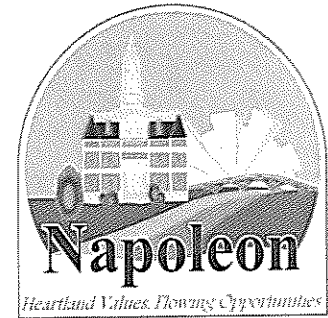

MAILBOX REPLACEMENT

The City of Napoleon has adopted the following policy regarding mailbox replacement, per Resolution No. 041-09:

“Mailboxes, including its post or other support, that are lawfully and properly constructed or placed in the City right-of-way and subsequently damaged or destroyed as a result of being actually struck by a City owned, leased, or contracted snow plow, will ***not*** be replaced by the city; however, subject to appropriation of funds, the owner of the mailbox may be compensated for his or her damages by the City in an amount not to exceed \$50.00 upon filing a claim with the City and providing the necessary release of further claims therefore.”

RESOLUTION NO. 041-09

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A POLICY STATEMENT OF THE CITY PERTAINING TO MAILBOXES STRUCK BY SNOW PLOWS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPOLEON, OHIO:

Section 1. That, the City adopts the following policy statement:

"Mailboxes, including its post or other support, that are lawfully and properly constructed or placed in the City right-of-way and subsequently damaged or destroyed as a result of being actually struck by a City owned, leased, or contracted snow plow, will not be replaced by the City; however, subject to appropriation of funds, the owner of the mailbox may be compensated for his or her damages by the City in an amount not to exceed \$50.00 upon filing a claim with the City and providing the necessary release of further claims therefore."

Section 2. That, it is found and determined that all formal actions of this City Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in open meetings of this City Council, and that all deliberations of this City Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and the Codified Ordinances of Napoleon Ohio.


Section 3. That, if any other prior Ordinance or Resolution is found to be in conflict with this Resolution, then the provisions of this Resolution shall prevail. Further, if any portion of this Resolution is found to be invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution or any part thereof.

Section 4. That, this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.


