Oakwood Park

Oakwood Ave.

52.0 Acres

Oakwood Park contains approximately 52 acres, 40 acres of which are fields and 12 acres are wooded. Through grants and private donations, the City of Napoleon was able to build one of the most attractive parks in the area. Oakwood park offers four (4) youth baseball diamonds, batting cages, a basketball court, a youth football field, restroom facilities, a beach volleyball court, playground equipment, shelter houses, a stocked fishing pond, a challenging and scenic bike/hiking trail, picnic areas, walking path, and ample parking.

Ritter Park

W. Riverview Ave.

5.6 Acres

Enclosed shelterhouse available for rental, volleyball court, horseshoe pits, shuffleboard court, boat launch, picnic tables, parking, restrooms, walking path and playground equipment. This shelter can be rented year around with the combination of a heater and a large fireplace. The restroom facilities and kitchenette area at the enclosed shelterhouse have been recently renovated.

Wayne Park

Wayne Park Drive

13.0 Acres

Enclosed shelterhouse, picnic tables, playground equipment, portable restrooms, drinking fountain, volleyball and parking. This shelter is also rentable during the spring and summer months.

East Riverdowns Park

E. Front and Jefferson St.

28.9 Acres

Picnic tables, restrooms, parking, drinking fountains, two softball fields, an arboretum and tree nursery, horseshoes, large playground, open shelter, and a volleyball court.

Vorwerk Park

E. Riverview Ave.

24.5 Acres

Picnic tables, grills, restrooms, fishing access, hiking trails, drinking fountains and parking.

Oberhaus Park

West Maumee Ave.

15.0 Acres

Rotary-Lions Community Center available for rental, flag football fields, walking trails, fishing/boat docks, parking, and natural areas.

Meyerholtz Wildlife Park

W. Riverview Ave.

21.5 Acres

Open shelterhouse, picnic tables, open grass area, path for walking/jogging and also parking area.

Glenwood Park

Glenwood Ave.

71.9 Acres

Two (2) open shelterhouses, lighted youth baseball diamond, Olympic size swimming pool, nine (9) hole golf course, lighted basketball court, picnic tables, volleyball facilities, skateboard ramp, parking, and the home of the **Kidz Kingdom** playground system.

Swearingen Park

South Perry and E. Barnes St.

1.0 Acres

Picnic tables, playground equipment, basketball court, recently added skateboard park, and parking.

Boatramp Facility (within Ritter Park)

14.8 Acres

Concrete ramp for boat launching, docks, open shelterhouse, picnic tables, parking, volleyball, playground equipment and restrooms. This facility has undergone an extensive renovation that included a new restroom as well as parking area improvements. In addition, new handicapped accessible courtesy docks have been recently added with the financial assistance of a Division of Watercraft grant.

Veterans Park

S. Perry St.

0.5 acre

Newly created park just southwest of the Maumee River Bridge. This park was funded, developed, and donated by the Southside Beautification Committee and includes veterans statues, gazebo, walking paths, and flower plantings.
