PARENTS CODE OF ETHICS

The National Alliance for Youth Sports, a nonprofit organization focused on Youth Sports ethics for coaches and parents developed a "Code of Ethics" for parents with children participating in recreation programs.

The Parks and Recreation Department staff, the Napoleon Baseball Association, and all of their volunteer supervisors and coaches ask that all parents read and adhere to the following ethics¹ during the upcoming season.

- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice or other youth sports events.
- I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of any personal desire to win.
- I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment
- I will provide support for coaches and officials working with my child to provide a positive, enjoyable experience for all.
- I will demand a drug, alcohol, and tobacco-free sports environment for my child and agree to assist by refraining from their use at all youth sports events.
- I will remember that the game is for children and not for adults.
- I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child.
- I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability.
- I will promise to help my child enjoy their youth sports experience within my personal constraint by assist with coaching, being a respectful fan, providing transportation or whatever I am capable of doing.
